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COUNTRY TOUCH

Please read all instructions carefully before starting. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut from selvage to selvage unless otherwise stated.

9-Patch Quilt Instructions approximate size: 40 1/2" x 40 1/2"

1. Cut the following: (cut larger pieces first as listed)

Fabric C - Cut 2 - 8 1/2" strips, subcut 5 - 8 1/2" squares

Fabric E - Cut 1 - 4 3/4" strip

Cut 1 - 5 1/4" strip, subcut 5 - 5 1/4" squares, cut in half diagonally from both directions

Cut 2 - 2 7/8" strips, subcut 20 - 2 7/8" squares, cut in half diagonally

BINDING - Cut 5 - 2 1/4" strips, sew end to end and press in half

Fabric F - Cut 1 - 7 1/4" strip, subcut 4 - 7 1/4" squares, cut in half diagonally from both directions

Cut 2 - 5 1/4" x 5 1/4" squares, cut in half diagonally from both directions

Cut 4 - 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares

Cut 4 - 1 1/2" strips, subcut 2 - 1 1/2" x 36 1/2" and 2 - 1 1/2" x 38 1/2"

Fabric G - Cut 1 - 4 3/4" strip

Fabric I - Cut 2 - 7 1/4" x 7 1/4" squares, cut in half diagonally from both directions

Cut 4 - 5 1/4" x 5 1/4" squares, cut in half diagonally from both directions

Cut 8 - 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares

Fabric J - Cut 2 - 7 1/4" x 7 1/4" squares, cut in half diagonally from both directions

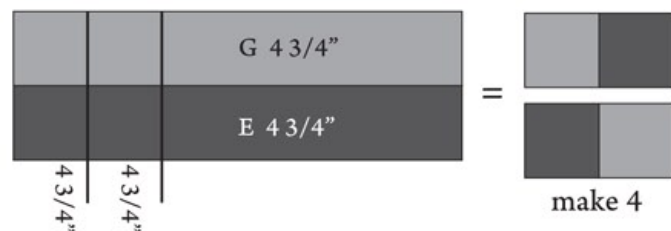
Cut 4 - 5 1/4" x 5 1/4" squares, cut in half diagonally from both directions

Cut 8 - 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares

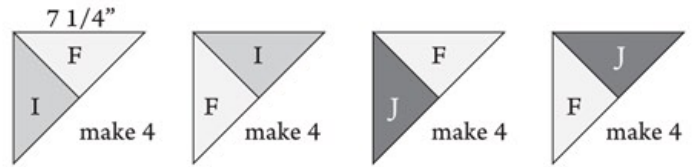
Cut 5 - 1 3/4" strips, sew end to end, then subcut 2 - 1 3/4" x 38 1/2" and 2 - 1 3/4" x 41"

2. Piecing Order:

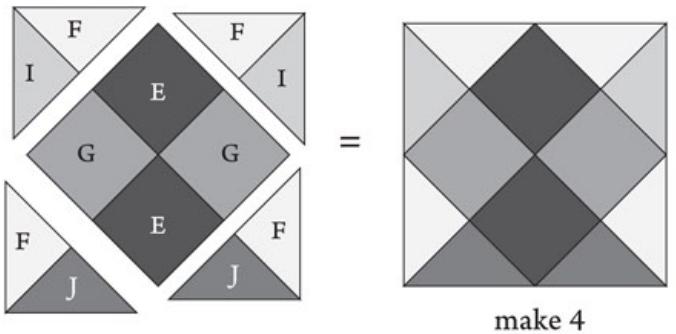
1. Make 4 - 12" finished (12 1/2" unf.) blocks. First, make 4-patch centers by sewing **G** and **E** 4 3/4" strips side by side. Press toward **E**. Subcut 8 - 4 3/4" segments, then sew segments together according to the diagram for 4 center blocks.



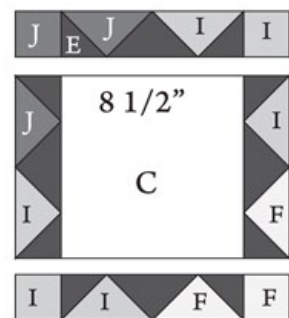
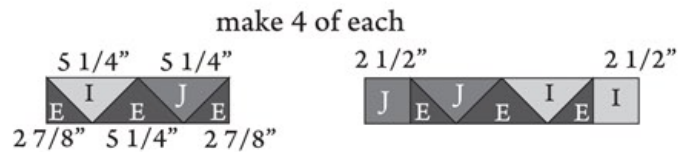
Next, sew **F**, **I** and **F**, **J** 7 1/4" triangles together according to the diagrams.



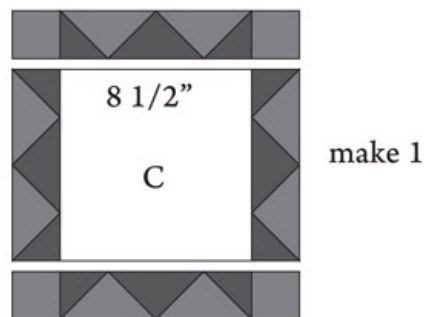
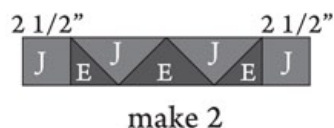
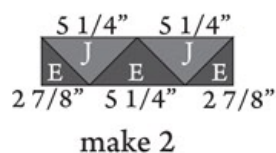
Then sew triangle pairs around the 4-patch centers, opposite sides first, then remaining sides according to the diagram.



2. Make 4 - 12" finished (12 1/2" unf.) corner blocks. First, sew 2 7/8" triangles, 5 1/4" triangles, and 2 1/2" squares together according to the diagrams. Then sew the shorter rows to the SIDES of 4 **C** 8 1/2" squares and sew the longer rows to the TOP and BOTTOM according to the diagrams. All 4 blocks are identical except the direction of **C** - see cover picture and diagram on the next page for each block.



3. Make 1 - 12" finished (12 1/2" unf.) center block. Sew 2 7/8" triangles, 5 1/4" triangles, and 2 1/2" squares together according to the diagrams, then sew the short rows to the sides of **C** 8 1/2" square and sew the longer rows to the top and bottom according to the diagram.

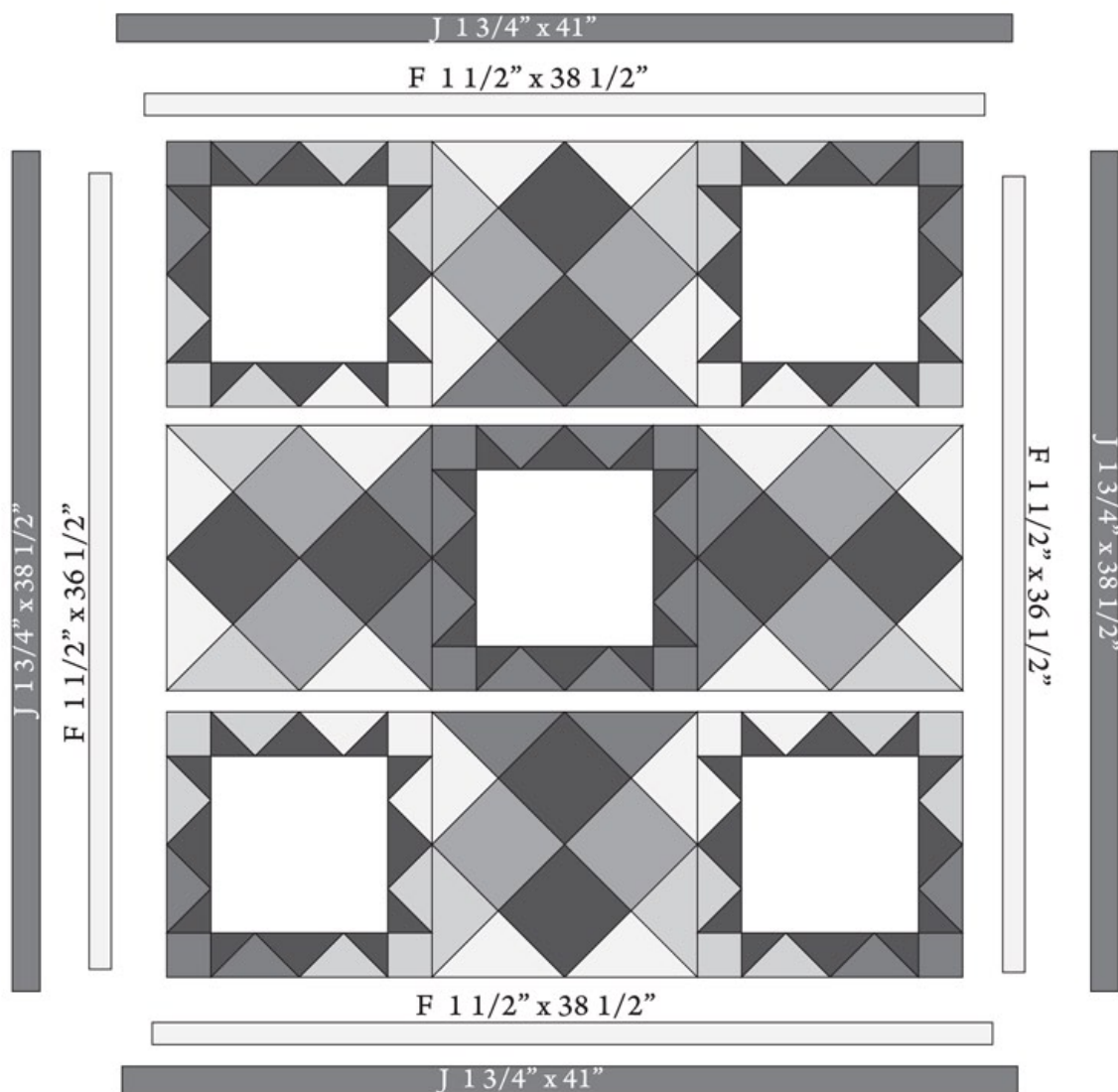


4. Make quilt center by sewing blocks into rows, then join rows according to the diagram. Pay special attention to the orientation of each block.

5. Sew **F** 1 1/2" x 36 1/2" to the SIDES, then sew **F** 1 1/2" x 38 1/2" to the quilt's TOP and BOTTOM.

6. Sew **J** 1 3/4" x 38 1/2" to the SIDES of the quilt, then sew **J** 1 3/4" x 41" to the TOP and BOTTOM according to the diagram.

7. The 9-Patch quilt measures approximately 41" x 41". Make backing (**Fabric C**) at least 8" larger than the top. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric E**) and enjoy!!



Wall Hanging Instructions

approximate size: 16 1/2" x 51"

1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - Cut 4 - 7 1/2" x 7 1/2" squares (center designs evenly)

Fabric B - Cut lengthwise 3 identical border stripes - 3 1/2" x LOF (approx. 60")

Fabric D - Cut 1 - 2" strip

Cut 1 - 3" strip

Fabric E - Cut 1 - 2" strip

Fabric F - Cut 2 - 2" strips

Fabric H - Backing - Cut lengthwise 1 - 17" x 51 1/2" (cut first)

Cut 3 - 3 1/2" x 9"

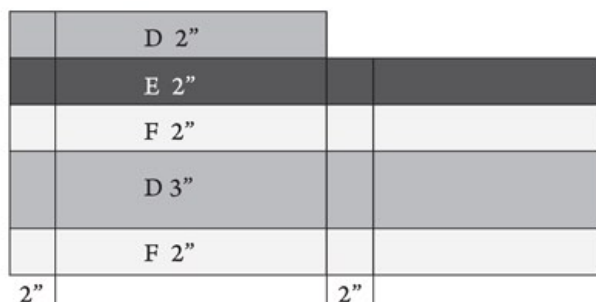
Fabric I - Cut 5 - 1 1/2" strips, sew end to end, then subcut 3 - 1 1/2" x approx. 60"

Batting - Cut 1 - 17" x 51 1/2"

2. Piecing Order:

1. Make 1 strip set by sewing **D** 2", **E** 2", **F** 2", **D** 3", **F** 2" strips side by side. Press to 1 side. Subcut 4 - 2" segments. Remove the outside **D** 2" strip, then subcut 4 - 2" segments.

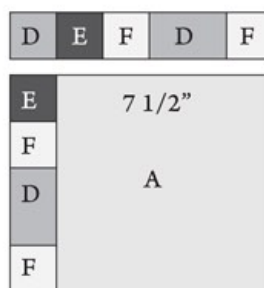

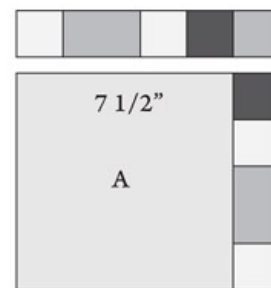

2. Make 4 - 8 1/2" finished (9" unf.) blocks. Sew the shorter segment to 1 SIDE of 4 **A** 7 1/2" squares (side of square rooster is facing), then sew the longer segment to the TOP according to the diagram.



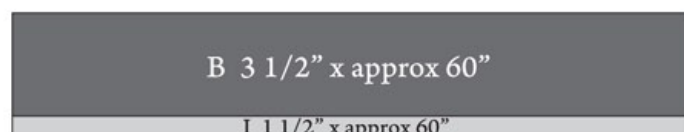

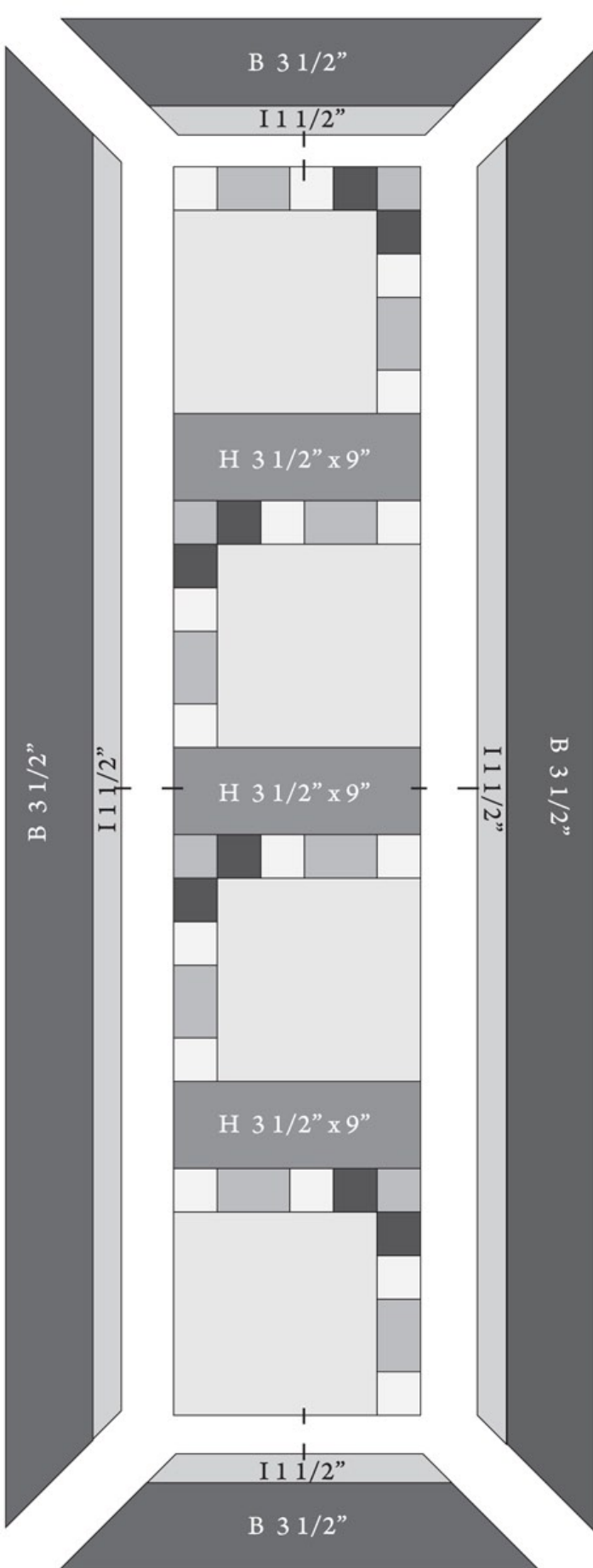

3. Sew center of Wall Hanging by alternating 4 blocks and 3 **H** 3 1/2" x 9" according to the diagram on the next page.
4. Borders: make 3 border strip sets by sewing **I** 1 1/2" x approx. 60" and **B** 3 1/2" x 60" side by side. Cut 1 strip set in half to be used for the TOP and BOTTOM. Fold the wall hanging in half to find the center of each side. Fold all borders in half to find the center. Center and stitch each border strip to the wall hanging, being sure to begin, end and backstitch 1/4" from each corner of the quilt top. Lay quilt top right side down with borders folded out. Lay 1 border over the other. Draw a straight line at a 45° angle from the inner to outer corner. Flip the positions of the borders and mark again from corner to corner. Place the 2 marked borders right sides together with pencil lines carefully pinned together. Sew directly on the pencil line, backstitching at each end. Trim excess fabric. Press seams open. Repeat and sew all mitered corners.

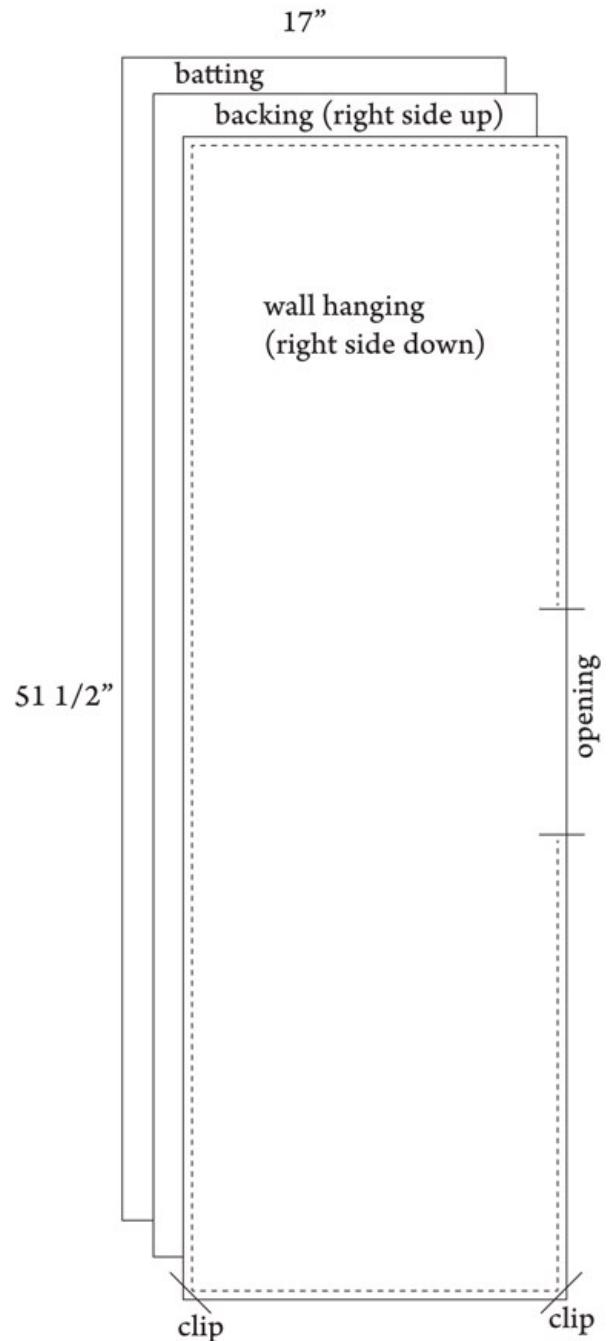

5. Finishing the Wall Hanging: Layer batting, backing (right side up), and wall hanging top (right side down). Match raw edges and secure layers with pins.

Stitch $1/4"$ around the outer edge of the quilt, leaving approximately 12" open in the middle of the side for turning. Clip corners and turn right side out. Stitch opening closed. Press. Top stitch $1/4"$ around the wall hanging to create faux binding. Add optional quilting and enjoy!!

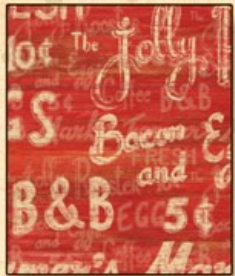
