Set of 8 Hexagon placemats.

Feature fabric: .55m
Felt: .60m
Batting/wadding: cotton approx .6m

Cut out eight hexagons from your feature fabric and eight hexagons from the batting/wadding.

Layer two hexagons together (one fabric and one batting) and quilt around the design on the feature fabric through both thicknesses.

Trim the batting/wadding so that the edges are about 1/8th" smaller than the fabric hexagon.

Cut eight squares of felt approximately 12" x 11". Place your quilted hexagon on top of the felt. Complete the quilting through all three layers where desired. Machine (or hand) stitch around the edge of the feature fabric hexagon with a button hole stitch.



Trim your felt to $\frac{3}{4}$ " beyond the buttonhole stitches.

Congratulations, you will now have eight stunning placemats.
