Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.


1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - Fussy cut panel to 23-1/2" square with wreath centered

Fabric B - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips the *length of fabric* parallel to selvage:
(4) 4-1/2" x 23-1/2" poinsettia strips as well as
(2) 2" x 43-1/2" and (2) 2" x 40-1/2" holly borders

Fabric C - Cut (1) 12-1/2" strip, subcut
(4) 8" x 12-1/2" pieces and (1) 7" square (then cut in half diagonally twice  for 4 triangles)
Cut (5) 5-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 5-1/2" x 43-1/2" and
(2) 2" x 53-1/2" borders

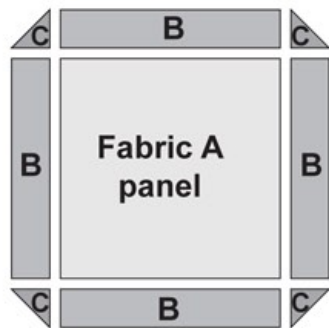
Fabric D - Cut (6) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Fabric E - Cut (1) 12-1/2" strip, subcut (2) 12-1/2" squares then cut in half diagonally twice  for 8 triangles

Fabric F - Cut (4) 1-1/2" strips, subcut
(2) 1-1/2" x 38-1/2" and (2) 1-1/2" x 40-1/2" borders

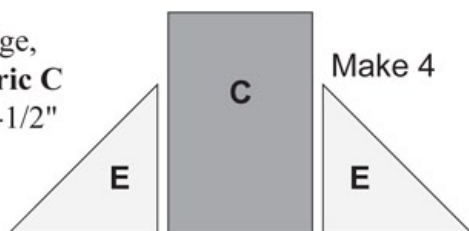
2. Piecing Order:

1. Arrange **Fabric A** panel with
(4) 4-1/2" x 23-1/2" **Fabric B** strips and **Fabric C** 7" triangles as shown. Sew pieces into rows, sew rows together. Make 1 bordered panel (unfinished approx. 31-1/2" square).

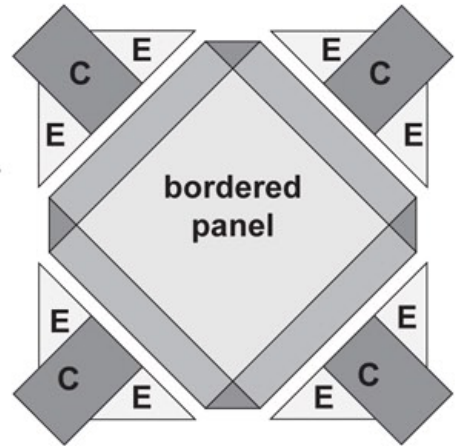
2. Aligning bottom edge, sew 8" x 12-1/2" **Fabric C** piece between (2) 12-1/2" **Fabric E** triangles. Make 4 corner units.

3. Stitch corner units to sides of bordered panel. Trim quilt center to 38-1/2" square.

4. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 2) for arrangement and placement of borders.



5. Sew 1-1/2" x 38-1/2" **Fabric F** strips to sides then 1-1/2" x 40-1/2" strips to top and bottom of quilt center.

6. Stitch 2" x 40-1/2" **Fabric B** borders to sides then 2" x 43-1/2" strips to top and bottom of quilt.

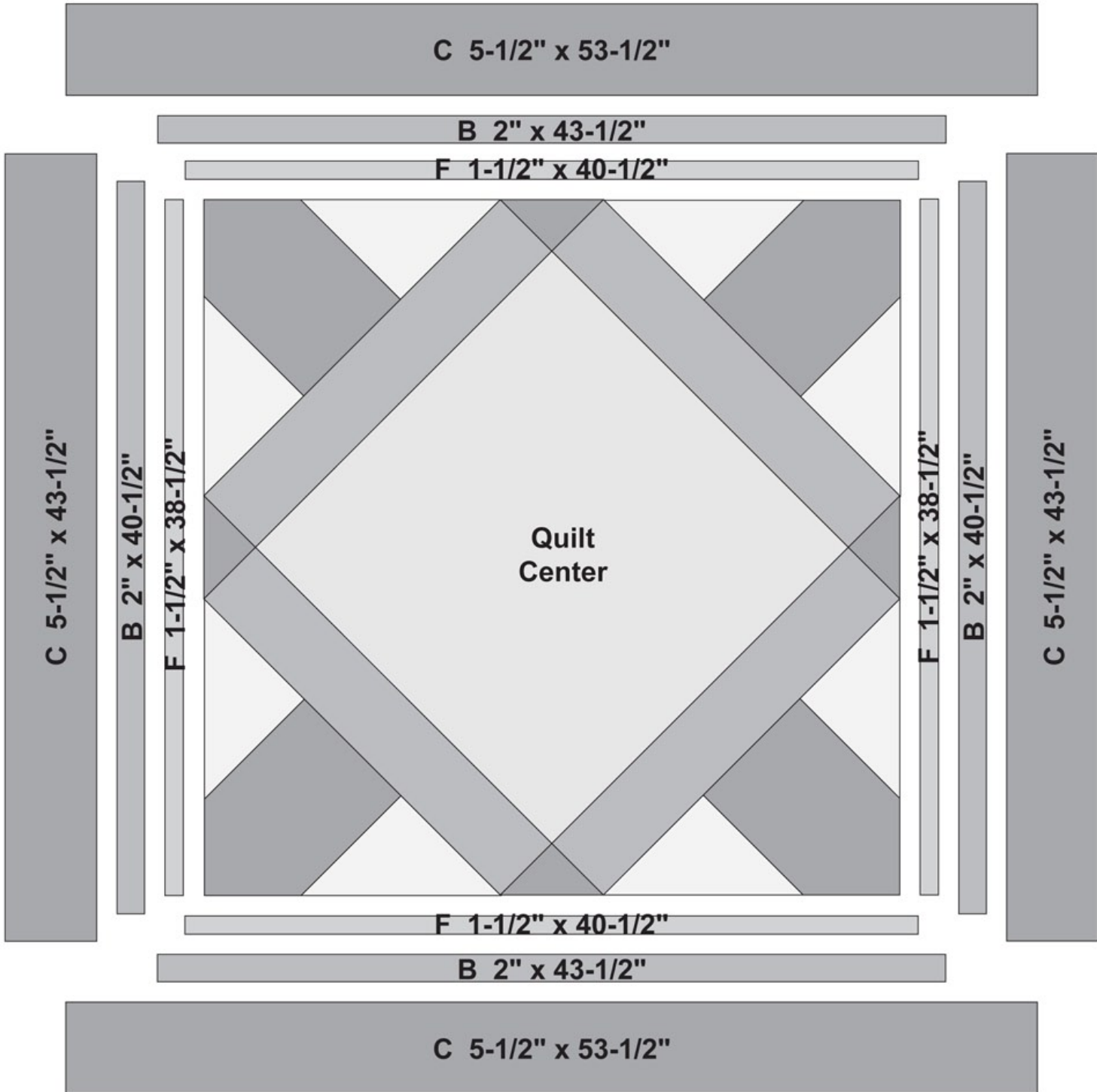
7. Sew 5-1/2" x 43-1/2" **Fabric C** strips to sides then 5-1/2" x 53-1/2" strips to top and bottom of quilt center.

8. The quilt measures approximately 53-1/2" square (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric G**) at least 8" larger than the top.

9. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric D**) and enjoy!!
