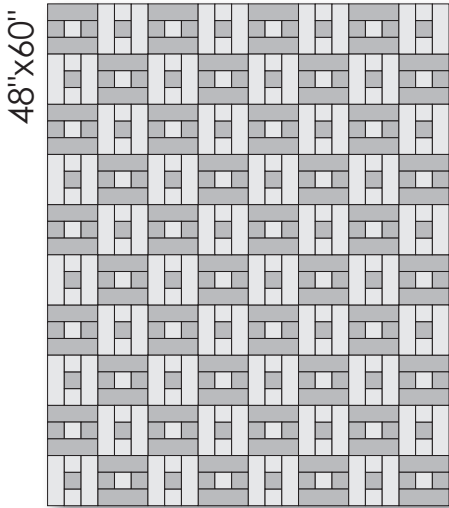

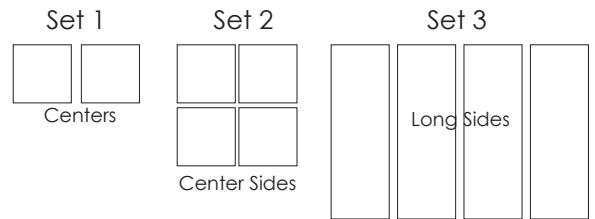

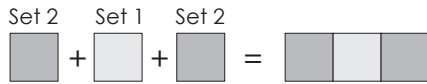
Jiffy Jelly™ Quilt

Requirements: 1 Moda JellyRoll™ · Plus 1/2 yd. for Binding

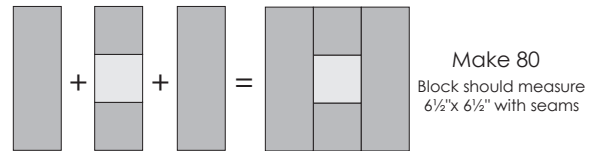
- 1 Unroll JellyRoll™ strips. Sort by color, but do not unfold.
- 2 Cut folded JellyRoll™ strips. First trim off the salvages. Then cut 3 – 2 1/2"x2 1/2" sections and 2 – 6 1/2"x2 1/2" sections for a total of 6 – 2 1/2" squares and 4 – 6 1/2"x2 1/2" rectangles. Sort pieces into sets – Set 1 Center Squares; Set 2 Center Sides and Set 3 Long Sides. See diagram.



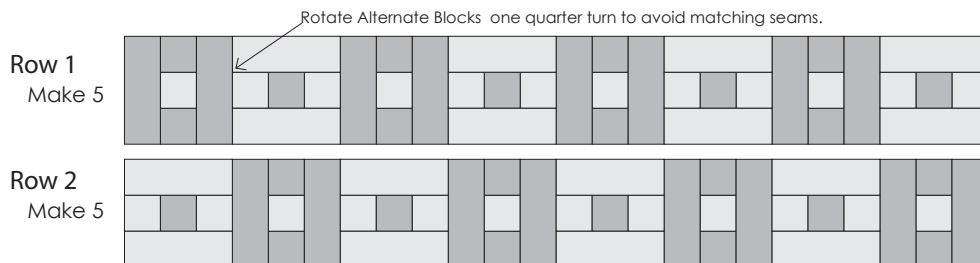
- 3 Select 2 like squares from Set 2 and sew to opposite sides of a contrasting square from Set 1. Press away from center square.



- 4 Add 2 matching strips from Set 3 to pieced squares to make 1 Jiffy Jelly Block. Press toward long sides. Block should measure 6 1/2"x6 1/2" with seams. Make 80 blocks – 40 "light" and 40 "dark".



- 5 Join 8 blocks, alternating light and dark to make a row. Make 10 rows of 8. Hint: Rotate alternate blocks a quarter turn to avoid matching seams.



- 6 Cut 6 – 2 1/2"xWOF strips for binding. Using a bias seam join strips end to end. Fold in half with wrong sides together. Press.

- 7 Layer, Quilt and Bind to complete your Jiffy Jelly™ Quilt!
